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Strictly Education Spring term 2024 – Online HLTA preparation cohort list

Delivery of HLTA preparation online is through 7 x 2-hour sessions which includes a tutor support session. These sessions are to prepare candidates for formal assessment for accreditation against the national standards for HLTA. Candidates <u>must</u> be able to attend all 7 of the sessions of the cohort.

Headteachers will be asked to provide confirmation that candidates are already working at a higher level of teaching support and to confirm the candidate meets all the HLTA standards.

Although delivered online the application requirements remain the same. All candidates must be working in school with experience of being involved with planning (not necessarily carrying out the planning) and delivery of 1:1, group and whole class teaching and learning activities leading to progress. All applicants must have, and be able to provide evidence of, level 2 (equivalent to GCSE A*-C grade qualifications) in both mathematics and English.
